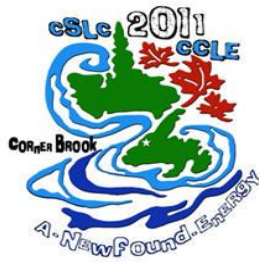

New Found Trade Show Rules and Regulations

1. Only exhibitors with educational related material/services that will be appropriate for our student delegates are permitted.
2. It is agreed that space will not be sublet without permission of the CSLE 2011 planning committee.
3. The exhibitor agrees to abide by the rules and regulations adopted by the CSLE 2011 planning committee in the best interest of the event, and agrees that the committee shall have the final decision in adopting any rule or regulation deemed necessary prior to, during and after the conference.
4. The exhibitor's property shall be placed on display and exhibited at the risk of the exhibitor. The CSLE 2011 committee and Corner Brook regional High assume no responsibility for the loss or damage to the property due to fire, theft or any cause beyond their control.
5. All goods shipped to the conference must be clearly marked with the name of the exhibitor and designated CSLE 2011. Goods that charge shipping on arrival to Corner Brook Regional High will not be accepted. Materials shipped should be addressed to:

6. Display set up will commence Thursday, September 29 from 2:00pm-4:00pm. Displayers who are unable to meet this requirement are asked to contact Heather Locke to make alternate arrangements.

7. The exhibitor agrees that the displays will be open from 9:00 AM to 5:00 Pm on September 30. No display shall be dismantled or goods removed during this time.

8: Masking tape only may be used on wall surfaces.

9. Exhibitors will be notified of which doors to use upon arrival. Students will be available to help unload and load displays.

10. The organizers reserve the right to make changes, amendments and additions to the rules and regulations as considered necessary for the proper conduct of the conference. Interpretations of the rules and regulations shall rest with the organizers and the decision shall be final.

11. In case of cancellation the exhibitor must notify CSLC 2011 two (2) weeks prior to the date of the conference in order to obtain a full refund. After that date no refund will be given.

12. Verbal abuse: Prior to the conference, an exhibitor that has been confirmed with booth space and verbally abuses anyone will have the booth space automatically taken away and will be fully reimbursed. The company name will be removed from all promotional materials. During the set-up of the displays or during the conference, an exhibitor who verbally abuses anyone will be asked to leave. No reimbursement will be made. In the event an offending company is represented by a sales representative, the head office will be notified in writing of the reasons for the expulsion of the exhibitor.

13. No smoking policy: The School Districts across Newfoundland and Labrador have declared school buildings and property as non-smoking areas. All exhibitors are asked to observe this rule.
